Lutheran High Northeast Tuition & Fees 2017-2018

FOR MEMBERS OF LUTHERAN HIGH SCHOOL ASSOCIATION CONGREGATIONS

Base tuition for 2017-18	\$7,055.00
Less LHSANN subsidy @ 25%	-\$1,763.75
Net member tuition	\$5,291.25

(The board has capped the tuition increase for 2018-19 at no more than 5%)

FOR NON-MEMBERS

Net tuition	\$7,055.00
(Tuition Payments to LHNE are NOT tax deductible)	

SIBLING DISCOUNTS

These discounts apply to any student who qualifies, regardless of LHSANN membership. Discount applies only to brothers/sisters also attending Lutheran High Northeast.

- 1st sibling @ 10% discount
- 2nd sibling @ 20% discount
- Additional siblings @ 25% discount

PAYMENT PLANS

- Families may choose to pay tuition several ways:
- * One annual payment (due by August) **receive \$100 credit**
 - * Semester payments (Aug + Jan) **receive \$50 credit**
 - * Monthly plans (beginning in September) - **requires Tuition Management Service**

SCHOLARSHIP ASSISTANCE

We will work to the best of our ability to help families afford the cost of Lutheran High Northeast. **We have up to \$150,000 available in scholarship assistance for 2017-2018.** Any family is eligible to apply for help. An application form and modest fee of \$30.00 are required. We use an independent company to assess our applications. A Financial Aid Committee makes the final recommendation. All financial information is treated with the utmost confidentiality.

TUITION MANAGEMENT SERVICE

Families choosing to pay by monthly plan are required to subscribe to a Tuition Management Service at a cost of \$40 to the family. These payments are automatically credited to Lutheran High Northeast on a monthly basis.
